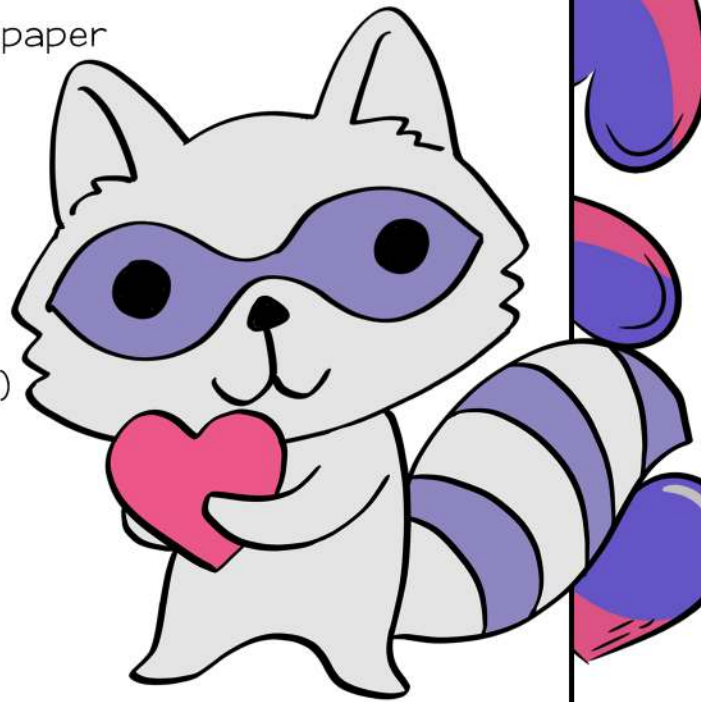


# Valentine Candy Party Favor

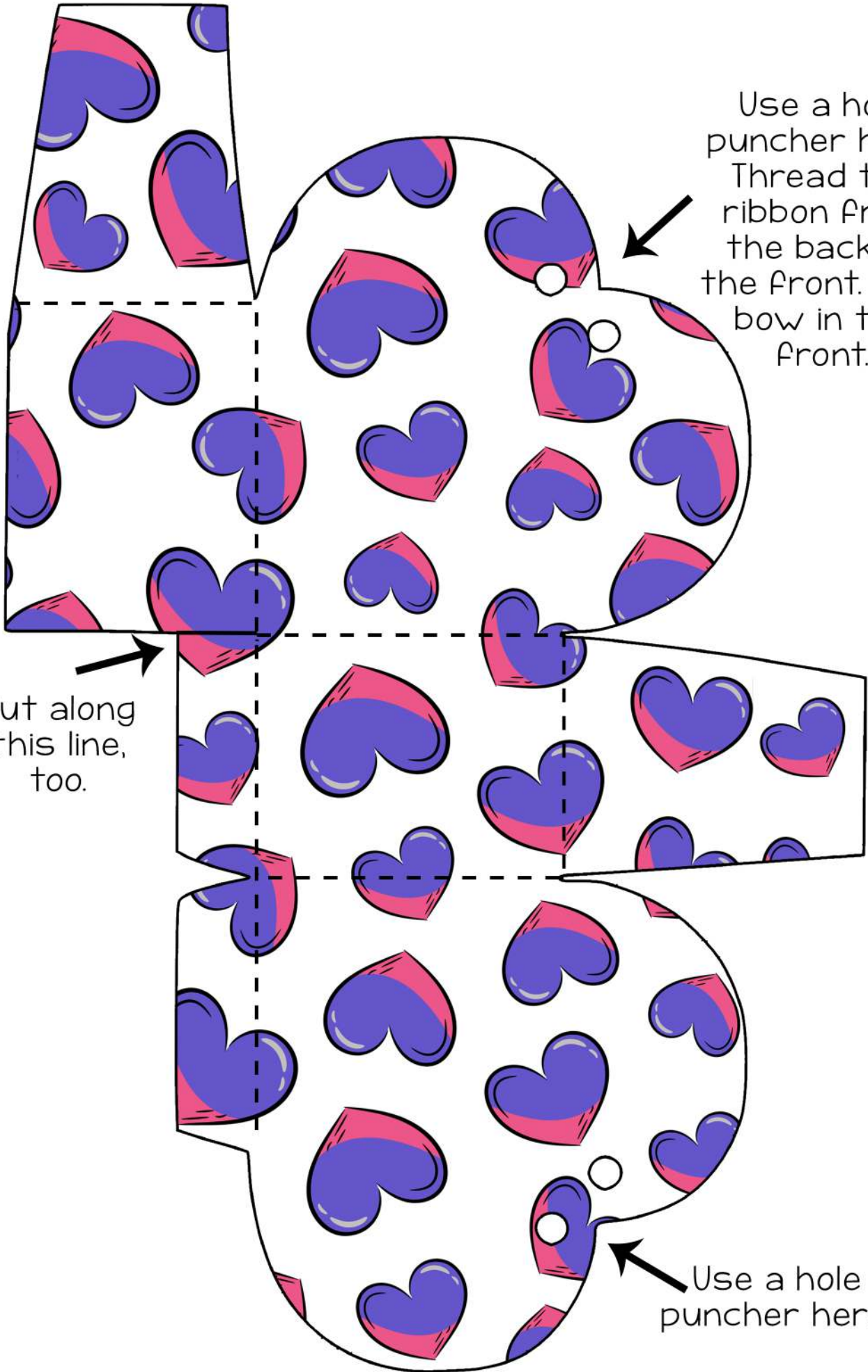
## Materials:

- Template sheets printed on cardstock paper (Instruction Sheet - optional to print.)
- Small, sharp scissors
- Ruler
- Glue or glue stick
- Clear tape
- Popsicle stick (optional - painted white)
- Crayons, markers
- Thin pink or red ribbon
- Hole punch
- Adult hands helping little hands



## Directions:

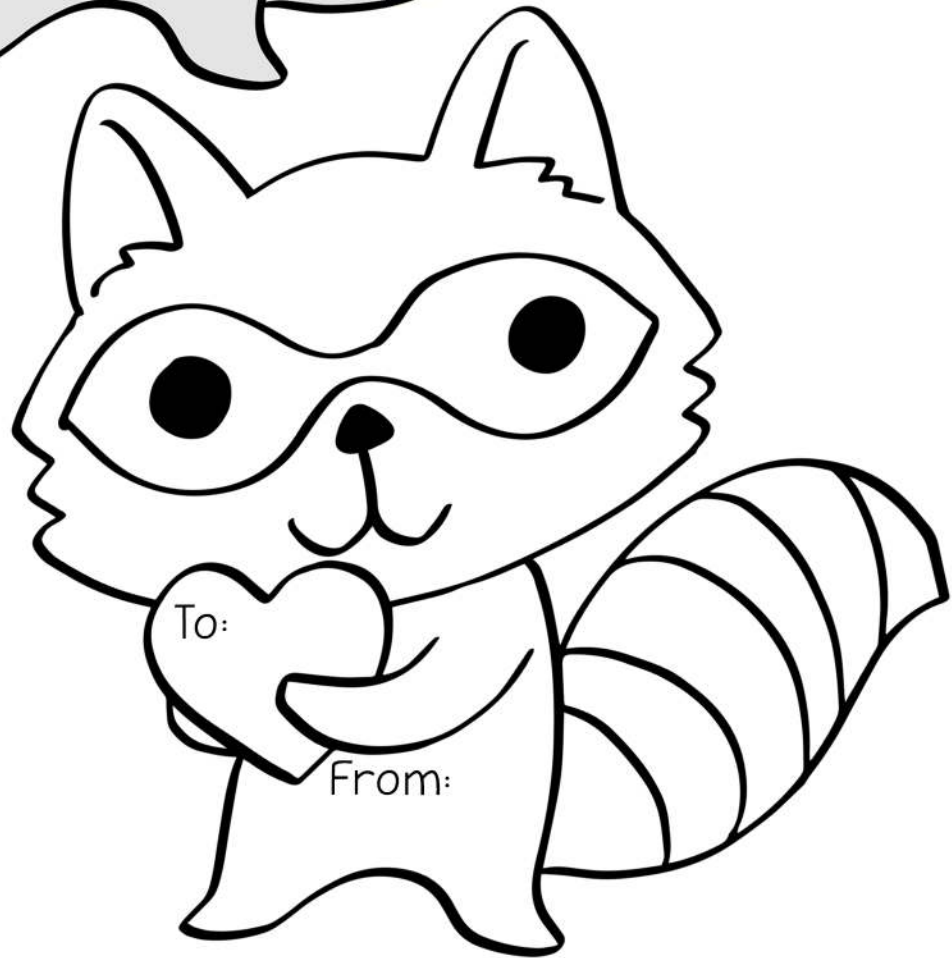
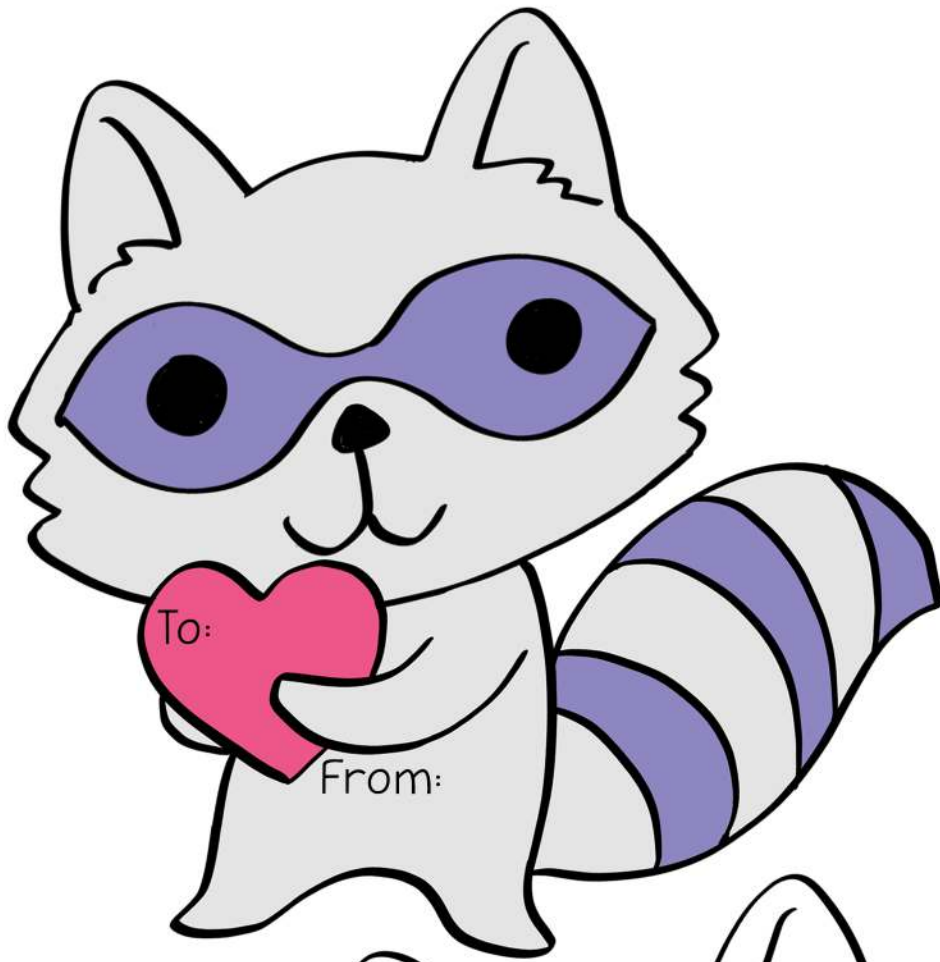
1. If you're coloring your own party treat, use crayons and/or markers to color the raccoon and the heart-shaped box pattern.
2. Cut out the raccoon and the box.
3. Fold the box inward, along the dotted lines.
4. Glue the tabs to the inside of the box that is formed. Leave the top two flaps open to insert candy.
5. Punch holes where the small circles are.
6. Pour candy into the top of the heart box. You may want to use some tape to secure the two flaps in place.
7. Thread the ribbon from the back to the front. Tie a bow in the front.
8. Using tape, or thick craft glue, fasten the top of a popsicle stick to the back of the heart-shaped box to use as a handle.
9. Next, glue the raccoon to the front of the box. His legs should be adhered to the outsides of the two holes.

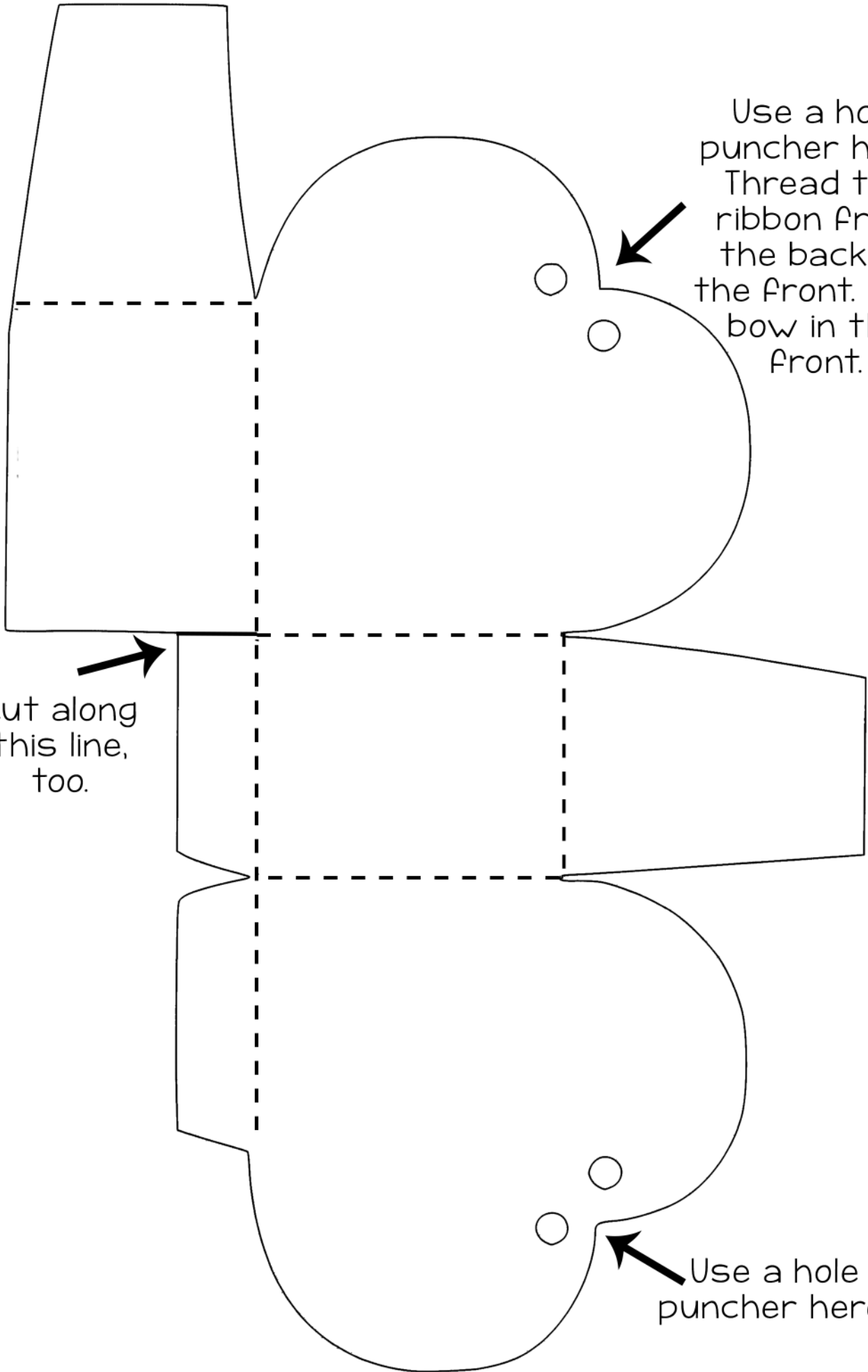


Use a hole puncher here. Thread the ribbon from the back to the front. Tie a bow in the front.
